### Summary of tournament conditions

- 1. The Tournament will be run in accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis.
- 2. The Kiama Tennis Club (KTC) Committee has the entire management of the Tournament.
- 3. The KTC Committee reserves the right to refuse entry into, or to combine or cancel events if considered insufficient entries have been received, or alter the program if deemed necessary.
- 4. Competitors entering doubles events should ensure that they preferably enter with a partner. The KTC Committee is not in a position to find partners for individuals, but will endeavour to secure a partner if requested.
- 5. The KTC Committee reserves the right to play any match under lights.
- Senior players will be eligible to play their age group during the full year i.e. a player who attains say 55 years on any date during, up to and including December 31st, will be eligible to play 55 events for the full year.
- 7. Minimum age requirement for Seniors competition is 30 years.
- 8. This is a Tennis NSW and Tennis Seniors NSW Sanctioned Tournament. For insurance reasons all players must be a registered member of their State Tennis Association and their registered number quoted. It is also requested that players be members of a State Seniors Association in order to show your support for Over 35s tennis. If you are not registered with a State Seniors Association, a fee of \$5 will be required to register as a temporary member for the tournament.
- 9. If more than the maximum number of entries is received, preferential acceptance into the Tournament will be given to entries accompanied by entry fees and to players who are registered members of a State & Seniors Association.
- 10. Attire: Players must be correctly dressed in recognised tennis attire.
- 11. Publicity & Promotion: Each player grants and assigns to Kiama Tennis Club Inc. the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time and at its discretion, motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of him/her during the event and in connection with the promotion of the event without compensation for him/herself his/her heirs, devisees, executors, administrators or assigns. Such promotional activities by KTC shall not be indentified as or represented to be an endorsement by the player of any product or company.
- 12. Each competitor must submit a signed, separate entry form, on or before the closing date of Wednesday 1 November 2023.
- 13. Only ONE event per time slot to be entered.
- 14. Winners Formula: Round Robin matches are a total of 9 games with a tie-break at 4 all. Winners will be decided on matches won. If equal, then on games won, and then if equal, winner will be on result of when they played each other. If still equal (e.g. 3-way tie), the prize money will be split between the winning players. If a tie-break is required, sudden death rules apply at 6-6.
- 15. Wet Weather Rules: Should the entire weekend be rained out, all monies will be refunded. Should play occur in any event and pools are a washout, the winner for any washed out pool will be drawn from a hat.
